Signing up for Final Exam

For schools that have scheduled exam times

For schools that do not have scheduled exam times

For students who wish to take their exam at the Indiana Online Office or Other Location

For students who are unable to take the exam at their home high school or the Indiana Online Office

Some students may use a remote proctor service called Proctorio to take their Final Exam

Signing up for Final Exam


- 1. To schedule the final exam, students **must** login to their <u>Indiana Online account.</u>
 - a. Students **must** use their login information (do not use the parent/guardian login)
- 2. Click on Final Exam Registration in the menu bar
- 3. On the **My Classes** page click **Make Reservation** for the Final Exam you're ready to schedule.



For schools that have scheduled exam times

- 1. Choose My School
- 2. Choose from a drop down list the dates and times available at the student's school. The dates and times are on a 'First come, First serve' basis. If you do not see a specific date or time, then that means the slot has been filled.
- 3. Click Save






For schools that do not have scheduled exam times

 Your school may request that you contact the school directly to establish a time for your exam as indicated on the reservation link.

For students who wish to take their exam at the Indiana Online Office or Other Location

- The student may choose to come to the Indiana Online CIESC office, by clicking 'Other locations/IOA Office' and selecting an available date and time. Driving directions to the Indiana Online CIESC office in Indianapolis are listed on this site as well.
- 2. Choose from a drop down list the dates and times available at Indiana Online or other options. The dates and times are on a 'First come, First serve' basis. If you do not see a specific date or time, then that means the slot has been filled.
- 3. Click Save





For students who are unable to take the exam at their home high school or the Indiana Online Office

- If the student is not near their home high school to take the final exam OR chooses not to take their exam at their high school or the Indiana Online CIESC office, they may take the final with a proctor conveniently located near them. Typically a local library, a tutoring center, community college, or any other educational center may be an option. The student is responsible for locating a proctor and setting up the date. This needs to be done at least 48 hours before the exam time.
- 1. Choose Alternate Arrangements
- 2. Click **Register** then fill out the form that will pop up and submit it

• The student is responsible for locating a proctor and setting up the date. This needs to be done at least 48 hours before the exam time.

You will need to know:

- Name of Site
- Date of Exam
- Address of Location
- Proctor Telephone
- Proctor Name (the alternate proctor cannot be a relative)
- Proctor Email (must identify the organization they represent, for example "@imcpl.org", ".lib", or ".edu")
- Proctor Occupation
- Fee Paid (if applicable)



The proctor's email must be an identifiable extension such as 'lib' for a librarian or 'edu' for a college and **cannot** be a Gmail or Yahoo email. The proctor cannot be a family member or friend.

Once you have the information needed, you will schedule your final exam through our system. Once the information is entered, we will verify and contact your proctor with instructions and guidelines for proctoring the exam.

If you are unable to schedule online, the proctor will need to contact the Indiana Online office at least 48 hours before the exam time for instructions. Ask the proctor to go to the website www.indianaonline.org, click Helpdesk, then complete the form requesting the final exam information. Indiana Online will email the instructions to the proctor once they have been verified.

Some students may use a remote proctor service called Proctorio to take their Final Exam

- This option is for students who are traveling, exam proctoring is not offered by their school, or the dates/times at the school are not convenient.
- The Google Chrome browser is **required** and you **must** be able to install an extension
- Prior to using Proctorio, you must register by logging into <u>indianaonline.org</u> and clicking on Final Exam Registration in the menu bar. The click on My Classes, then Make Reservation and choose Remote Proctor. Click Register then fill out the form that will pop up and submit it, then instructions for using Proctorio will be emailed to you.

- Exams are \$10 each, paid by the student through the Proctorio application (Credit Card or PayPal).
- Students **must** have a PC, Mac, or Chromebook computer that is equipped with a webcam.
- You must be able to install an extension on the device.
- Tablets, Hybrid Devices, and Mobile Devices are not supported.
- Student must take the final exam via Proctorio by the **close of business** (4:30 p.m. EDT) on July 18, 2019.
- Directions for computer setup to use Proctorio will be emailed to you. There are also directions found in your course.
