Re: Indiana Online Summer School Program

As schools begin to plan for their upcoming summer school, Indiana Online would like to partner with you to deliver a variety of quality courses in order to meet your students' needs. In an effort to reduce the cost to the student while continuing to offer an effective and quality program, all summer school fees will be paid by the district with no additional fee charged to students for any summer school enrollment when a district signs a summer school agreement. The regular cost of a summer school course is \$275. By signing this agreement, the district agrees to pay the Central Indiana Educational Service Center (CIESC) at a discounted rate as outline below. A \$50 administration fee will be charged for any student who is withdrawn from the course after June 6, 2022.

- CIESC Member schools - \$210 per enrollment
- ESC Member schools - \$235 per enrollment
- Non ESC Members/Homeschool - \$250 per enrollment

The school has the option of opening Summer registration as early as the contract is received. Standard registration is from April 4 - June 3, 2022. The Agreement must be submitted in order to open enrollment. The summer session begins June 6 and ends July 17. All exams can be taken within the course without a proctor. Final grades will be available to download from the Indiana Online Student Information System no later than July 25, 2022.

If no Agreement is received, we will assume the district will not be participating in the Indiana Online summer school discount option. Students will be given the opportunity to take online summer school courses at their own expense at the full tuition rate.

## **The advantages of partnering with the Indiana Online for Summer School:**

- Cognia (formerly AdvancEd) Accredited, NCAA approved AP courses approved by the College Board audit.
- Curriculum is aligned to the Indiana Academic Standards.
- Courses are developed and taught by Indiana licensed teachers.
- Districts can provide a variety of courses without the need to meet the 15 student minimum or hire several different teachers.
- A cost effective way to offer a summer school option for students.
- The district will be charged a discounted rate per enrollment for any students who remain in the course after the June 20, 2022 withdraw date.
- Online courses allow flexible hours that enable students to travel and participate in other activities during the summer.
- Very low staff requirements. Your school will be responsible only for approving courses, providing contact information, and retrieving final grades from the Student Information System.
- Indiana Online provides students an opportunity to retake courses to stay on track for graduation or take courses that will free up their schedules for the next school year.
- Students in your district will be able to take Indiana Online summer courses at no cost rather than paying the full tuition amount.
- All enrolled students have access to a non-graded free readiness course in Geometry, Grammar, Writing, Calculus, and College English.
- Final course grades will be available to the school by Monday, July 25, 2022.

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
